## **Pensacola Historical Society to Host 20th Annual Haunted House Walking and Trolley Tours – Tickets on Sale Sept. 14!**

**PENSACOLA** - Be frightened again as Pensacola Historical Society hosts its 20<sup>th</sup> annual Haunted House and Trolley Tours fundraiser. Let our costumed guides scare you with horrifying tales of Pensacola's darker history on our annual ghost tours. Celebrate this special anniversary by fearlessly joining a new tour called "Murder and Meyhem!" Brave participants may choose between a walking or trolley tour – if you dare!

Tours are Friday and Saturday evenings Oct. 15, 16, 22, 23, 29, and 30. Walking tours leave every 30 minutes from 6 to 8:30 p.m. Trolley Tours leave at 6:30 p.m, 7:30 p.m, and 8:30 p.m. All tours will leave from the Pensacola Historical Museum (115 E. Zaragoza St.) and will last one hour. Tours go on rain or shine!

Special ticket prices for anniversary! Walking Tour tickets are \$10 for adults and \$2 for children 12 and under. Trolley Tour tickets are \$16 for adults and \$4 for children 12 and under. Reservations and advanced payment are required. No refunds will be given, as this is a fundraiser for the nonprofit Pensacola Historical Society, a division of West Florida Historic Preservation, Inc.
